Middle Island at 3 A.M. dropped anchor
at 9 took it again after light breeze
from N.E.

Monday July 16th

First part calm at 6 P.M. took
ship south by the getting the breeze
Middle Island from N.E. after
heavy rainy weather latter part
the same

Tuesday July 17th

First part strong breeze from N.E.
thick rainy weather ship under short
sail and number of ships seen at
anchor and rather much wind
Middle the same latter calm

two of them sailing Middle Island for
Middle and latter part the same

the anchor and commenced making up
Eastward Middle and latter part calm
