had the stayboat boat stopped in the boat
harbor middle latter thick fog water
employed sending down for top gallant
mast

Tuesday Aug 7th

First part calm with thick fog
water employed sending up masts
for top gallant mast - middle and latter
part the same water employed
putting new hoops on the scuttled boat
