First part light breeze from the
North ship steering East Middle and
latter part the same

Thursday Aug 23rd

First part thick heavy weather ship
steering S. by E Middle part
steering N.W. latter part the same

Friday Aug 24th

First part strong breeze from the N.W.
ship steering S. by E at 2 P.M. and numerous
white whales seen at five o'clock came
on board at 7 with out getting fast
Middle and latter part light baffling air, saw
nothing

Saturday Aug 25th

First part fine clear weather some
sprinkling at 6 P.M. spoke
the ship 6.30. Reason Middle and latter
part weather the same
