 Ship hauled back on the ice



Tuesday Aug 28th
 First part blowing strong from
 the north ship being under
 close reefed main but sail employed
 backing Middle and latter part thick
 and rainy
 Sailed by 5³⁰ P.M.

 Wednesday Aug 29th
 First part water employed backing
 Middle and latter part the same

Thursday Aug 30th
 First part light sailing in three Bant
 whaling whaler Starboard Boat struck killed
 and drag him to ship
 Middle part calm latter part employed
 cutting in



Friday Aug 31st
 First part light breeze from N.E. these
 sails in sight Middle and latter part
 blowing strong from N.E. thick rainy weather
 employed standing down
 Stowed 25.25 gally
