at sunset took in sail, heavy island bearing
SE dist 12 miles Middle and
Latter part strong breeze.

First part strong breeze from
SE at sunset the island Martin
bearing SE 15 miles dist
Middle and Latter weather the same
at 11 AM spoke the ship Ensign
of New Bedford 500 tons

Thursday Dec 13th

First part fine weather at sunset
Martin bearing SE 10 miles dist
Middle and Latter part weather
the same

Friday Dec 14th

First part fresh breeze from the East
with fine clear weather at sunset the
island of Martin bearing SE dist 20 miles
Middle and Latter light breeze
ship working to eastward

Saturday Dec 15th

First part light breeze from the
eastward ship bearing the windward
Middle and Latter part the same

Sunday Dec 16

First part light breeze from the
East ship working to westward at
sunset east wind bearing SE 8 miles
dist Middle and Latter part weather
the same
