the same
Lat by M 15 48 N
Long by M 147 16 W

Monday Dec 31st

First part fine clear weather
at 8 P.M. spoke B. 19 bearing
round to Sabita Middle and latter
part weather the same

Tuesday Jan 1

First part fine weather at sunset
the East end of the island of St. John
bearing S. by E 11 miles distant from
S. H. I. yet sea watches Middle and latter
strong breeze with squalls of rain

Wednesday Jan 2nd

First part light baffling wind with
heavy squalls of wind and rain at 3 P.M.
about an hour on the west end of the island
of Appatachi at 5 returned with 100 barrels
at sunset west end bearing S. by E 4 miles distant
wind from eastward Middle and latter part
the same

Thursday Jan 3rd

First part strong breeze with
heavy squalls of rain and wind at 4 P.M.
about an hour on the west end of
Ayba at 6 returned with about 30 barrels
Middle and latter light baffling air with heavy
squalls of rain
