light airs with squalls of rain

Long in 137 59 W

Tuesday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>

First part light breeze from  
N.E. ship heading S.W.  
Middle and latter part  
the same

Sat by 11.00 P  
Long in 138 31 W

Wednesday Jan 28<sup>th</sup>

First part light breeze from  
N.E. steering S.W. off sun, at  
Magdalena Island heading N.W.  
Middle and latter

of the Marquesas Islands, 1858

Thursday Jan 31<sup>st</sup>

First part light breeze from N.E. ship  
heading off and on at Magdalena Island at  
11.30 P. part went ashore at the wharves  
with about 2000 about load of flour  
took up 2000 lbs ship heading to Westward  
with heavy gusty winds Middle the same  
latter light breeze from N ship heading  
to westward

Friday Feb 1<sup>st</sup>

First part light breeze from the  
N.E. ship heading to westward  
Middle and latter the same

Saturday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup>

First part light breeze from Westward  
with thick sunny weather Middle the same  
latter wind from Eastward
