First part fine clear weather
wind from the Eastward Middle
and latter the same

Tuesday Feb 5th

First part fine weather ship lying
at anchor in harbor of Red Bank
Middle and latter
strong breeze with heavy squalls of
rainy aft. White and walking
on shore

Crossing of Marguerite island, 1856

Wednesday Feb 6th

First part fine weather ship lying off
anchored at Helms island raft and
the King on shore at 7 AM returned
with eleven fish and shells from
Middle and latter strong breeze at 8 AM
raft and the King went ashore

Thursday Feb 7th

First part strong breeze at 7 AM
Boat returned with 9 fish and 2 crabs
Middle and latter part weather the
same

Friday Feb 8th

First part fine clear weather at
2 PM came to anchor in harbor
Bay Nanka here found four ships and
three boats lying at anchor there
