 Thursday Feb 21st
 Fine clear weather

Friday Feb 22nd
 Fine clear weather at 6 AM
 took the anchors and stood out to sea

Two men on board that came away from
 the ship (Argentine of New Bedford)

Saturday Feb 23rd
 First part light baffling air,
 Middle and latter the same

Bowd to S. F. Island 1854
 Sunday Feb 24th

First part light breeze from NW
 high heading NW at sunset changed
 island bearing 10 miles distant Middle
 and latter the same

Lat 41, 6 32 S

Monday Feb 25th

Strong breeze from Eastward ship
 heading to the North at 1 PM. landed
 three boats for spar on which stood
 boat struck mast and ladder struck
 keel and took them to ship picked
 up one dead one taking them to the ship
 to Middle and latter weather the same
 at day light commenced sailing



Tuesday Feb 26th

First part entirely breeze from the
 Eastward employed cutting at 5 PM
 finished part of the fluke before but missed
 the whale. Middle and latter part weather
 the same employed observing the
 heads
