Sunday Mar 16th

First part strong trades all
day steering N.W. by W. to
Middle and latter the weather the same
steering N.W. by W. at 10 A.M. arrived
Cyber

Latitude 19.40 N.
Longitude 156.42 W.

Monday Mar 17th

First part light to moderate ship
steering N.W. by W. Middle and
latter steering E by N

Tuesday Mar 18th

First part strong trades steering
N.W. by W. at sunset the West end of
Hawaii bearing N.W. by W. 20 miles distant
reduced the top sail and came to anchor
Middle the same latter all sail
light air and calm

Bound to S. W. Japan 1856

Wednesday Mar 19th

First part light air, and calm
at 4 P.M. took in light sail,
the ship lay to anchor at dawn
bearing South 15 miles distant
Middle and latter making up to
anchors age

Thursday Mar 20th

First part working ship's anchors up
at 4 P.M. came to anchor in view
San Francisco water

Employed stowing down spars
etc. in the main hatchway

Friday Mar 21st

Fine weather Employed stowing
down
