Sunday June 22nd

First part fresh breeze from the south steering N.E. by N Middle and Latter strong gale from the Eastward ship under close reefed top sail at day light five sails in sight

Monday June 23rd

First part strong gale from the Eastward spoke ship Thimble one whale this season Middle and Latter the same
