Wednesday July 2nd

First part light air from the westward
with rain. Middle the same. Latter
light breeze from North east point
bearing S. W. by S. dist

Thursday July 3rd

First part light breeze from the
North. Ship two South. Middle the
same at 4 P.M. got through boiling
Latter calm

Friday July 4th

First part light air from the south
ship bearing two south. Middle,
and latter the same. Employed stowing
down in main hatchway

Saturday July 5th

First part light air from the south
one sail in sight. Middle and latter
weather the same at 7 A.M. lowered
fore Boats for whale. S. Boat struck ball
and took him tow ship.



Sunday July 6th

First part calm. Employed cutting
Middle weather the same. Latter strong
breeze from the S. W. at daylight commenced
boiling

Monday July 7th

First part strong breeze from S. W.
Employed boiling. Middle and latter
the same S. B.
