Wednesday Aug 13th

First part light breeze from the south
with thick fog weather Middle and
Latter the same at 6 A.M. picked up
a whale commenced cutting at 11. commenced
Bailing spoke ship Esie for whales
M.B.



Thursday Aug 14th

First part strong breeze from the
south with thick fog Middle and Latter
the same

Sat by 10 56.30 N
Long. 163.52 W

Friday Aug 15th

First part strong gale from the
westward ship under close reefed main
top sail employed Bailing heaving to
the M. Middle and Latter the same
M.B.

in Bristol Bay 1856

Saturday Aug 16th

First part strong breeze with thick weather
at 7 P.M. saw numbers of whales going quick
to the wind and Middle and Latter weather
the same. Employed standing down

M.B.

Sunday Aug 17th

First part strong breeze from the south
with thick fog saw plenty of whales Middle
and Latter light breeze from M. at 8 A.M.
hauled fore Boats for whales Box Boat struck
killed and took him to ship commenced cutting
At 2 P.M. finished



Monday Aug 18th

Strong breeze from the westward one sail
in sight Middle and Latter strong gale
from M. ship under close reefed main
top sail heaving to 2 P.M.

Sat by 10 56.23 N
Long. 163.25 W
