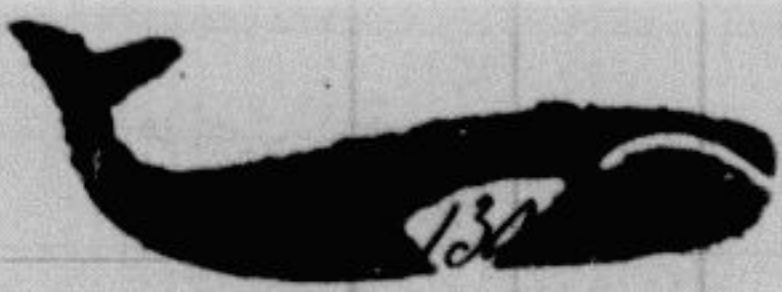


Ship Triton of New Bedford
