the Boat struck got stove lost 2 jars fine
fathoms line

Monday Sept 8th

First part strong breeze Employed Boiling
Middle finished latter strong gale from
W. employed standing down

in Bristol Bay 1856

Tuesday Sept 9th

First part strong gale from N.E. saw
a dead whale fallen to him with four jars
and four lines took them to ship Middle and
latter weather the same at 3 P.M. these jars were
and one line parted

Wednesday Sept 10th

First part blowing heavy ship under close
reefing till 12 saw the whale lashed
the Boat got two lines fast to him and took them
to ship Middle and latter weather the same
at 4 P.M. lashed him to ship and commenced
cutting the body of the whale

First part strong gale from the westward
employed cutting at 3 P.M. finished
Middle and latter weather the same Employed
Boiling
