First part fine weather at 6. P. M.
shook ship again of New Bedford
to whaler Middle and Latter strong
breeze from the North heading West
No. 10

Saturday Sept 20th

First part strong breeze from North
ship heading N. whaler double reefed
Middle and Latter the same

in Bristol Bay 1856

Sunday Sept 21st

First part gale from N. N. W. heading
West shook ship about 800 hundred. Bent off
Middle and Latter strong breeze from the westward
heading to N. No. 10

Monday Sept 22nd

First part strong breeze from the Westward
with thick foggy weather and a double reefed
top sails heading to N. Middle the same
Latter light airs from the North
No. 10

Tuesday Sept 23rd

First part light air from the North
ship steering West Middle and Latter
weather the same at 8 P. M. saw the
island of St. Paul
