S.W. 20 miles dist. N.W. by way about
at daylight kept on steered for the harbor

Sunday Nov. 16th

First part of my voyage at 1. P.M.
first came at 4. P.M. came to anchor
in lower bay of San Pedro at 12. got under weigh
at 2. came to anchor in Chetita
at 4. but the watch goes on here James Cook
and William Bering get drunk, and were
but in the fort
