First part strong trades ship sailing
along the West side of Horn Island
Middle being close heading to the West
latter sailing along N. side of Horn Island

Friday Dec 19th

First part strong trades ship sailing
on shore on the west side of Horn Island
at 5 P.M. set sail with one piece
of no account and some trunks Middle
heading to West and a double reefed top sail
latter all sail heading to South

Saturday Dec 20th

First part moderate breeze with squalls
of rain all sail heading the ship at sunset
the land of Matia bearing off S. ship heading
S. this day recovered that the first in fore
top mast was rotten and replaced several times
over the top Middle and latter all
sail heading to the South

in the South Pacific 1856

Sunday Dec 21st

First part fine weather all sail
heading to the South Middle and
latter weather the same ship heading
to West

Set by N 15.30 S

Monday Dec 22nd

First part fine weather all sail
heading to West at 5 P.M. took off
ship Horn Island bearing off N. 1. 1. 1.
Middle and latter weather the same
suffered fitting fore top mast to use to us and
making new fids for the fore top mast and fore
top of mast

Set by N 15.49 S
Long to West 147 33 W

Tuesday Dec 23rd

First part fine weather heading to West
at 4 P.M. took off ship heading to West
Middle and latter the same
