

Ship Triton of New Bedford

Friday Jan 30th

Sight breeze employed Baiting Middle
with Patter weather still some rain
finished Baiting at 4 P.M. 1854
Saw 138.05 W

Saturday Jan 31st

Sight breeze steering W. by N.
at 2 P.M. saw the island of Magdalena
Middle lying aback Satter standing in for the
island

Sunday Feb 1st

Sight breeze lying off and on at Magdalena
Capt on shore at 6 P.M. returned with food
chickens, coconuts and one pig & Middle and Satter
steering to the N.W. short sail

Monday Feb 2nd

Sight breeze steering N. by W. at 6 A.M.
saw the island of Revolution Bay bearing S. 25° W.
Middle the same at daylight Bait for five fish
dist at 4 P.M. Capt went ashore at 6 P.M.
returned with a load of Potatoes and two pigs

Tuesday Feb 3rd

Lying off and on at Rapa Nui Middle and
Satter the same got off six Boat loads of wood
and one load of Potatoes

Wednesday Feb 4th

Lying off and on at Rapa Nui Middle and Satter
the same at 1 P.M. Capt went ashore with
and Ben Boat with him at 6 P.M. Boat returned

Thursday Feb 5th

Lying off and on at Rapa Nui at 4 P.M.
Starboard and Whist Boat returned with about
two hundred coconuts and about 2500 yams &c.
and one man to work his passage to the N.W.
island as some other folk Middle and Satter
dealing to windward

in the South Pacific 1854

Friday Feb 6th

Sight breeze beating to windward at sunset
between the islands of Maikoa, Rapa and Washington
Middle and Satter heading S. by E

Saturday Feb 7th

Sight breeze from the east all day beating
to the windward Middle and Satter the same

Sunday Feb 8th

Sight breeze from the E. heading N. by E. at
sunset at Washington land bearing S. by E.
11 miles dist Middle lying aback Satter steering
N. by W.

Sight by 11 7.44
Long " also 140.04 W

Monday Feb 9th

Sight breeze heading N. by E. Middle short
sail heading to the N. Satter steering S. by E.
at 9 A.M. windward island at 10h saw Bottom
island 6 miles dist

Sight by 11 7.44
Long " also 140.04 W

Tuesday Feb 10th

Sight breeze from the east and sailing along
the N.W. side of the island of Maikoa at sunset
the island bearing S. by E. 1 mile dist Middle
and Satter heading N. by E.

Wednesday Feb 11th

Light breeze at 2 P.M. gave aboard
at 4 P.M. three boats at Boat struck
S.B. and B.B. gave chase to school at sunset
S.B. struck a large whale part about 10 minutes
from boat some distance at 5 P.M.
at daylight sent him in
