

Remarks on Board Ship Triton the 2d. for the 1st.

Lat. 41.42. N. Long. 147.18. W. Thursday 7 of May 1857.

Came with strong breezes from S.E. Course N by E. Dark and cloudy, with rains all sail set at 5 P.M. breeze in Middle part strong breezes & thick fog with rain. Latter part more moderate & thick fog so ended the Day.

Lat. 43.57. N. Long. 146.24. W. Friday 8 of May.

Came with fresh breezes from S.W. Course N by E. thick fog the water employed in various parts & Middle part fresh breezes. Latter part the same so ended.

Lat. 46.00. N. Long. 145.53. W. Saturday 9 of May.

Came with strong breezes from S.W. Course N by E. at 4 P.M. on boat & sent the new fore sail at 6 P.M. Course N by W. wind the same. Middle part strong breezes from N.W. Course N by W. Latter part the same. The water employed in ships duty the carpenters employed in building a new cockhouse aft on the quarter deck. weather thick & hazy so ended the 24 hours.

Lat. 48.23. N. Long. 145.53. W. Sunday 11 of May.

Came with moderate breezes from the S.W. Course N by W. weather thick and a heavy heavy overcast at 4 P.M. Mended the storm aft washed of the decks for Sunday. with rains. Middle part fresh breezes and showers of rain. Latter part the same at 9 A.M. the wind hauled a head headed off to the N. & N by E. wind N by W. so ended.

Lat. 50.18. N. Long. 145.28. W. Monday 11 of May.

Came with moderate breezes from the W. by W. sharp on the wind to the N.W. weather quite thick at 4 P.M. lifted up moderate breezes from the same nothing in sight. Middle part light air and fine weather. Latter part the same wind S. Course N by W. so ended.

Lat. 51.28. N. Long. 145.07. W. Tuesday 12 of May.

Came with light air from S. Course N by W. weather thick at times with showers set the storm in the cabin. No whales but plenty of birds. Middle and latter part fine & clear weather moderate breezes from the N. all sail set on the eastern tack so ended the Day. at 7 A.M. took in sail for the first time.

Remarks on Board Ship Triton the 13th on Kodiak Kodiak

Lat. 52.38. N. Long. 147.18. W. Wednesday 13 of May 1857.

Came with fine and pleasant weather heading to the eastward wind from the north and westward. Middle & latter part fresh gales from N.W. ship under short sail heading to the northward & eastward.

Lat. 55.48. N. Long. 146.24. W. Thursday 14 of May.

Came with fresh gales from the N. sharp on the wind under short sail heading to the N.W. saw several phinbacks at 7 P.M. with air from the N. heading N. Middle part strong breezes from S.E. Course N.W. thick fog at daylight. saw at 9 have two took in fore & mizzen topsails blowing fresh so ended.

Lat. 57.34. N. Long. 145.07. W. Friday 15 of May.

Came with fresh breezes from S.E. ship have two heading N.W. weather thick and foggy at 3 P.M. lifted up set 4 mizzen top sails at 4 shot in at dawn two main yard a bark at 5 took in all sail to stow reef main top sail for the night. Middle part thick foggy and light rain. Latter part the same at 5 A.M. saw ship Cincinnati. Stowing two Chan.

Lat. 58.14. N. Long. 147.04. W. Saturday 16 of May.

Came with light air from S. sailed to the N. thick foggy. saw several ships through the fog at 5 P.M. took in sail. Middle & latter part strong breezes from S.W. course. weather thick.

Lat. 56.01. N. Long. 145.40. W. Sunday 17 of May.

Came with fine & pleasant weather strong breezes from S.W. Course N. at 7.30 took in sail for the night sharp by the wind to N.W. Middle & latter part clear weather & fresh breezes from the S.E. Course N.W. at 11 A.M. saw several phinbacks so ended.

Lat. 57.34. N. Long. 145.07. W. Monday 18 of May.

Came with strong breezes from the E. Course N.W. saw ship William West. clear. saw several phinbacks at 8 P.M. took in sail heading to the eastward. Middle & latter part fresh breezes from the N.E. sharp to the N. at 9 A.M. saw the land to the N. & ships in sight so ended.

Lat. 59.12. N. Long. 145.12. W. Tuesday 19 of May.

Came fine and pleasant weather land fine sight to the N. dist. 35 miles at 8 P.M. Middle & latter part fine weather at 5 A.M. spoke ship good return one whale this season & saw her take another so ended the Day.
