

Remarks on Board Ship Triton the Whaling on Kodiak.

Mr. Lath 53.52. N. Longchr. 146.24. W. Tuesday 2. of May. 1857.

Came moderate breezes from N. Course S.S. fine and pleasant.
in the plenty of plankton all sail set bound to the S.
Middle and latter part fresh breeze & thick foggy so ends.

Mr. Lath 53.52. N. Longchr. Wednesday 3. of June.

Came moderate breezes from S. sharp on the wind to the
Southward weather in hurry thick all sail set through the 24 hours
Middle & latter part strong breezes from N. & steady
with thick foggy and rain so ends the 24 hours.

Mr. Lath 53.52. N. Longchr. 149.25. W. Thursday 4. of June.

Came fresh gales from N. & thick foggy & rain at 4 P.M. close reef
the topsails took in main sail & fogs. Middle & latter part
Middle & latter part fresh gales from the S. and thick foggy

Mr. Lath 53.52. N. Longchr. Friday 5. of June.

Came strong gales from the S. at 12.30. took in all sails
down to close reef main topsails plenty of rain and foggy
the barometer is very low down to 28.66. at 7 P.M. wore
ship to the west in order to save our boats. Middle &
Latter part strong gales with foggy & rain so ends.

Mr. Lath 53.52. N. Longchr. Saturday 6. of June.

Came fresh gales at 2 P.M. wore moderate to double
reef topsails weather thick & heavy at 7 P.M. took
in sail thick foggy. Middle & latter part lth air
from the N. & thick weather nothing seen through the day

Mr. Lath 53.56. N. Longchr. 149.0. W. Sunday 7. of June.

Came lth air from the S.W. steering to the N.W.
Sharp on the wind the barometer steady on 28. whole weather
to with. Middle & latter part lth air from the S.W.
Course S.W. by N. attended with thick foggy and lth rain
all sail set to the best advantage so ends the 24 hours

Mr. Lath 54.04. N. Longchr. 150.22. W. Monday 8. of June.

Came moderate breezes from S.S. Course N.W. S.S.W.
weather thick & heavy and small rain all sail set to the best
advantage. Middle & latter part fresh breezes from the
N. Course by compass S.W. a few plankton seen
through the day so ends the day

Mr. Lath 53.56. N. Longchr. 153.15. W. Tuesday 9. of June.

Came fresh gales from N.W. Course S.W. by Compass at 3 P.M.
close reef the topsails took in the main sail blowing on
weather quite clear. Middle & latter part strong gales from
N. heading to S.S.W. by compass double reef topsails so ends the day

Mr. Lath 53.52. N. Longchr. Wednesday 10. of June.

Came strong gales from N. sharp on the wind to the S.W. by compass
at 4.30. took in fore & Mizzen topsails & spanker. Middle & latter
part moderate all sail set with the wind to the S.W. sharp on
the wind to the S. so ends the 24 hours.

Mr. Lath 53.59. N. Longchr. Thursday 11. of June.

Came lth air from the S.W. at 1. P.M. wore ship to the S.W.
with fine and pleasant weather the Captain and Cooper employed
in the hole checking the oil which was all a drift and we have
been pumping oil ever since we left wahoo i hope that
the hole will stop to it. Middle & latter part lth air
from the S.W. and thick foggy so ends the day.

Mr. Lath 53.55. N. Longchr. Friday 12. of June.

Came with lth breezes and thick foggy all sail set bound
to the N.W. sharp with the wind S.W. no whales on the ground
Middle & latter part fresh breezes from the N. heading to the
N.W. so ends the 24 hours & no whales.

Mr. Lath 51.15. N. Longchr. 156.43. W. Saturday 13. of June.

Came fresh breezes and clear weather wind S.W. heading S.
at 1. P.M. wore ship to the N.W. at 6 P.M. wind half to the S.W. Course
N.W. bound in to Komagings Island to wood Middle & latter part
strong breezes from S.W. Course S.W. weather fine and clear so ends.

Mr. Lath 53.22. N. Longchr. 157.55. W. Sunday 14. of June.

Came fine and pleasant weather moderate breezes from the N.
Sharp on the wind to the S.W. at 3 P.M. equal of rain not much
Down all sail set to the best advantage. Middle & latter part fresh
gales from the N.W. steering to the S.W. sharp on the wind under double reef
topsails fine & clear weather not a cloud to be seen in the horizon so ends

Mr. Lath 53.52. N. Longchr. 158.10. W. Monday 15. of June.

Came more moderate at 4 P.M. moderate breezes from the same heading
to the westward. Middle part fine & pleasant latter part fresh gales.
& clear weather nothing in sight so ends the 24 hours.
