

Remarks on Board Ship Triton ²² Whaling in Bristol Bay 1857.

Mr. Latt. Long chr. Tuesday 1st of July.

Came fresh gales from the W. hudding to the N. Employed in Bailing with berry short sale out. Middle part raining. Latter part part more moderate set close reef topsails. Employed in Bailing so on the 24 hours.

Mr. Latt. 57.20 N. Long chr. Wednesday 2nd of July.

Came moderate weather ship under short sale. Employed in Bailing saw several hump backs. Middle & latter part lite air from the W. sharp on the wind to the S.W. under short sale employed in stowing down forward at 4. AM Mm caught several cod fish at the same time cooled down the works so on.

Mr. Latt. 57.21 N. Long chr. Thursday 3rd of July.

Came fine and calm weather rather hazy at times employed in stowing down oil forward ship under short sale wind N. sharp on the wind to the S.W. Middle part thick fog. Latter part clear weather & lite winds employed in stowing down oil forward so ends the day.

Mr. Latt. Long chr. Friday 4th of July.

Came lite air at 1. PM. Sat all sale wore ship to the Westward at 4.30. all stowed down cleared the deck. Middle & latter part fresh breezes from the W. sharp on the wind to the S.W. at Daylight employed in repairing the windluffs weather thick & hazy all sale set

Mr. Latt. Long chr. Saturday 5th of July.

Came strong breezes from the W. sharp on the wind to S.W. weather thick the watch employed in repairing the battant to the windluffs at 7. PM. Double reefed the top sails weather squally Middle & latter part fresh breezes from W.S.W. hudding to the N.W. employed in fixing the windluffs saw plenty of humpbacks so ends the 24 hours.

Mr. Latt. Long chr. Sunday 6th of July.

Came moderate weather and thick employed in fitting the windluffs at 7. PM. spoke Barque type of stamming tower & whale Capt went on board weather moderate. Middle & latter part moderate weather and cloudy at 8. AM. saw fresh ship to windward and saw several hump backs so ends the day.

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Latt. Mr. 56.27 N. Long chr. Monday 7th of July.

Came lite air from the W.S.W. ship by the wind all sale set weather cloudy at 2.30. saw one rite whale going quick to the W. leaved but no go at 5. PM. Came on board spoke French ship full of harver capt came on board ship hudd to the W. Middle & latter part calm at 10. AM saw whales to a distance leaved but did not see them any more at 1. PM. came on board & ends the day.

Latt. 57.30 N. Long chr. Tuesday 8th of July.

Came thick weather & calm. Saw several Breaches to a Dist when clear. the Cooper employed in setting up Shooks caught several Codfish. Middle & latter part moderate and thick weather saw a ship so ends

Latt. 57.00 N. Long chr. Wednesday 9th of July.

Came strong breezes & thick fog from the E. by the wind to the S.E. at 3. PM. thick & raining at 7. PM. Double reefed the topsails took in main sale & fought hudding to the S.E. Middle & latter part fresh breezes from the S.W. hudding to the N.W. at 5. AM. wind from S.W. thick fog at 10 saw ship to the windward leaved at half past 11. saw whales so ends

Latt. 58.27 N. Long chr. 165.14 W. Thursday 10th of July.

Came fresh breezes from S.W. at 12.30. leaved for whales at 1.30. L.B. struck L. B. Strong breezes at 4. PM. iron Drawed came on board Double reefed the topsails took in fight & main sale. Moderate gales and thick weather Middle & latter part strong gales from E. hudding to S.W. at Daylight saw plenty of whales ship with short sale & ends the 24 hours.

Latt. 58.27 N. Long chr. Friday 11th of July.

Came thick weather and strong gales from E. sharp on the wind to S.W. started 4. Bags of flour. Middle & latter part strong gales from the S. ship under S. lost reef topsails and fore sale thick foggy and raining weather saw 2 ships so ends the 24 hours.

Mr. Latt. Long chr. Saturday 12th of July.

Came fresh gales & thick foggy with much rain wind from the S. sharp on the wind under S. lost reef topsails hudding to the E. at 7. PM. wore ship to the S.W. Middle & latter part fresh breezes from S. steering to the W. at 10. AM. lite air from the same sound.

Mr. Latt. Long chr. Sunday 13th of July.

Came lite air from the S. Barque type of stamming tower & whale Capt went on board at 2. PM. saw whales leaved at 6. PM. spoke ship's proboscis & whales the season. Middle & latter part quite moderate at 10. AM. saw whale leaved no go came on board saw 2 ships wind from the W. all sale set at 11.30. thick foggy so ends
