

Remarks on board ship Triton. ^{the} D. Cruising of St. Pauls. S.S. 1857.
Lat. 57. 33. N. Long. chr. 167. 45. W. Saturday 22nd of August.

Came fresh gales & clear weather from the E. Ship under short sail
huddling to the S.E. employed in stowing down oil in the after hold
Saw several ships on boiling at 10. P.M. saw nine whales loosed
but no go came on board at 6. P.M. oil all down 45. 14. gallons.
Middle & Latter part strong gales from the E. & S. Ship
under short sail thick foggy and rain so ends the day.

Mr. Latt. Long. chr. Sunday 23rd of August.
Came fresh gales and thick foggy & rain from the S.E. ship
under S. short reef topsails by the wind. Middle & Latter part
Moderate and thick foggy, at daylight heavy sea on
Dotted both boats. Latter part employed in repairing.
Boats saw several ships and no whales so ends the day.

Mr. Latt. 57. 54. N. Long. chr. 168. 26. W. Monday 24th of August.
Came fresh breezes from the S.E. by the wind. Cruising
weather thick & heavy & small rain at 10. P.M. moderate
saw one ship to the S. Middle & Latter part fine air
from the S. at daylight saw 4. ships at 11.30. saw
whales loosed but no go came on board so ends

Latt. 57. 54. N. Long. chr. Tuesday 25th of August.
Came light airs from the S. at 2.30 the boats came on
board thick rain and a strong breeze from the
S.W. at 6. P.M. spoke ship John eggshells on
whale loosed for whales. S. B. struck and turned over
board the whale and lines. Middle & Latter part fresh gales
& thick foggy and small rain so ends the day.

Mr. Latt. Long. chr. Wednesday 26th of August.
Came strong gales from the W. & thick rainy weather
wind from the W.S.W. at 5. P.M. took in fore & Mizzen
topsails & fore course at 5.30. Cleared reefed the main topsails
Middle & Latter part. calm and thick foggy & ships
so ends

Mr. Latt. 57. 55. N. Long. chr. Thursday 27th of August.
Came light airs from the W. Quarter of the compass cloudy
at intervals the carpenter at work repairing the S. B. at
4. P.M. put her on the cranes at 7. 2. ships to the S.
Middle & Latter part fresh breezes from S.E. by the wind
at 11. A.M. spoke Barque Isabella & whales the season
so ends.

Lat. 57. 57. N. Long. chr. 167. 45. W. Friday 28th of August.

Came fine & pleasant weather jamming with Barque Isabella top down
& whale the season saw several ships to the S.E. & of them boiling at 7. Don taken.
Middle & Latter part fresh breezes from the S. at 4. A.M. the wind held
to the W. at 11. A.M. course S.E. by S. several ships in site and no whale

Latt. 57. 48. N. Long. chr. 168. 00. W. Saturday 29th of August.
Came fresh breezes from the W. course S.E. by S. several ships in site
at 3. P.M. saw whales going quick to the windward loosed but no
go came on board at 5. spoke Barque silver cloud & whales
ships several & whales & no ships brought ship Flarady 4 barrels of flour
back here in. Middle & Latter part fresh gales and clear weather
Several ships in site through the day so ends the day.

Latt. 57. 00. N. Long. chr. 167. 41. W. Sunday 30th of August.
Came fresh gales and clear weather from the W. at 1. P.M. set
Double reef topsails by the wind to the S. more moderate no whales
Middle and Latter part fresh breezes from the W. at 10.
A.M. course S.E. by S. fine and clear weather. Several ships
in site all day. So ends the 24. hours.

Latt. 57. 17. N. Long. chr. 166. 19. W. Monday 31st of August.
Came fine and clear weather and fresh breezes from the W.
Course S.E. by S. saw several phin backs at 4. P.M. course S.E.
all sail set to the best advantage. Middle & Latter part
strong breezes from the S.W. ship by the wind with short
sail so ends the day.

Latt. Long. chr. Tuesday 1st of Sept 1857.
Came fresh gales and cloudy weather from the S.W. ship by the wind
to S.E. with short sail at 7 P.M. took in the fore sail and furl
Middle and Latter part fresh breezes from the S.W. course S.E. by S.
at 9. A.M. course E. with the air rather foggy and dark weather
so ends.

Latt. 55. 26. N. Long. chr. 165. 20. W. Wednesday 2nd of Sept.
Came light airs and cloudy weather from the S.W. at 1. P.M. Course.
By compass E. & S. Middle & Latter part moderate breezes from the
W. course S.E. weather quite thick at 11 and 45. saw the land
from E. to S. first 15 miles so ends the day.
