

Remarks on Board Ship Triton ^{the} D. D. Cruising in Bristol Bay 1857.
Mr. Lath 55. 26. 4. Long chr. Thursday 3rd of Sept.

Com fresh breezes and cloudy weather at 1. P.M. wore ship to the N.W. all sail set the land in sight to the southward & eastward Dist. 10. Miller saw several walrus at 5. P.M. saw whales leaved 4. Boats no go came on board whales galled by porpoises at 7. 30. Shortline sail for the nite. Middle & latter part calm & little air from the S.W. ship by the wind to the S. the land in sight to the eastward Dist 20 miles so end the 24 hours.

Mr. Lath 55. 11. 4. Long chr. 164. 16. 4. Friday 4th of Sept.
Com fine and pleasant weather and calms the land in sight to the southward and eastward Dist. 20. Miller by observation Middle and latter part little air and thick cloudy weather land in sight at times so end the 24 hours.

Mr. Lath Long chr. Saturday 5th of Sept.

Com fine and pleasant weather and little air from the S.W. at 1. P.M. 2. Boats went on shore for eggs and to catch a walrus but no go could not find any at 4 came on board stood to the N.W. by compass with all sail set to the best advantage Middle and latter part moderate breezes and fine weather wind from the E. Course N.W. so end the 24 hours.

Mr. Lath Long chr. Sunday 6th of Sept.
Com fine and pleasant weather moderate breezes from the E. Course N.W. at 2. sent down cutting blocks to repair at 3 sent them up a gain saw 2. whales leaved for them but go at 5 came on board at 6. saw a ship one to the E. & one to the W. bound south Middle & latter part strong breezes and foggy rainy weather so end.

Mr. Lath Long chr. Monday 7th of Sept.
Com strong breezes thick & cloudy weather from the E. course N.W. ship under short sail 3. Double reef top sails at 6. course N.W. 13. 4. Middle and latter part moderate and thick weather nothing to be seen through the day so end the day.

Mr. Lath Long chr. Tuesday 8th of Sept.
Com little air from E. course N.W. all sail set to the best advantage thick foggy at 6. P.M. the wind hald to the S.E. course S.W. by 4. Middle and latter part quite moderate and the thick weather at 10. A.M. led up saw a hump backs at 11. 30. sounded 16 fathoms of water so end.

Remarks on Board Ship Triton ^{the} D. D. Bound to St. Mathias Island
Mr. Lath 59. 14. 4. Long chr. 167. 2. 4. Wednesday 9th of Sept. 1857.

Com fresh breezes from the S.W. Course W. weather fine and pleasant nothing to be seen but green water. Middle and latter part fresh breezes from the S. Course W. weather rather cloudy so ends.

Mr. Lath 60. 09. 4. Long chr. 170. 25. 4. Thursday 10th of Sept.
Com fine & pleasant weather fresh breezes from the S.W. Course N.W. at 4. P.M. wind S.W. Course N.W. at 5. P.M. saw whales leaved for them but saw them no more at 5. came on board the Island of St. Mathias in sight bearing N by N by compass at 7 P.M. Dist. 18. Middle & latter part strong breezes of and on the land at daylight stood in at 7. 40. sent 2. Boats on shore saw several white bears at 8. 20. to 8. Shot a Bear took him to the ship so ends.

Mr. Lath Long chr. Friday 11th of Sept.
Com fresh breezes from E.S.E. running down the Island of St. Mathias 2. Boats on shore at 3. P.M. 2. B. Boat shot one white Bear at 4. took him to the weighing a boat 1000 lbs. stood of shore for the nite. Middle and latter part moderate and some rain thick at times the watch employed in cutting up the Bear salted two quarters which made 2. Barrels lye out one half of the bladder we obtained 10. gallons of oil the land in sight Dist. 8. to 10. M.

Mr. Lath Long chr. Saturday 12th of Sept.
Com little air from the E. ship by the wind of to the north of the Island saw rich whales leaved for the going quick to the windward came on board at 4. P.M. Calm the Island Dist. 8. Middle to the S. saw one ship to the N. to a distance. Middle & latter part little air and rainy course S.W. wind saw at daylight saw whales to the S. saw one offshore stood for him so end the day.

Mr. Lath 61. 00. 4. Long chr. Sunday 13th of Sept.
Com fine & pleasant weather whales in sight at 1 P.M. leaved 2. Boats but no go at 4. P.M. came on board were in shore Middle and latter part moderate breezes from the E. ship by the wind on both tracks so end the 24 hours.

Mr. Lath 61. 09. 4. Long chr. Monday 14th of Sept.
Com fine and pleasant weather all sail set by the wind cruising for whales at 6. P.M. saw whales leaved 2. Boats but no go at 6. came on board thick and rainy took in sail. Middle & latter part strong breezes from the N. ship by the wind thick and rainy ship under short sail at 7. 40. saw back bound S.W. supposed to be the Baya Tammur Row so end the day.
