Tuesday Dec 29 Begins with a light breeze veering Round to S.E. with overcast weather, at 6 p.m. Rain Middle and Latter parts Blowing a gale from N.W. with Rain and under the Close Reef Main top sail, have new Wheel Hoops, foremast staysail hails and fore top sail Chelines

Wednesday Dec 30th first part a strong gale from N.W. and dark cloudy weather, at 8 p.m. wind hauled suddenly to S.E. and blew very hard, at daylight more moderate set the Double Reef Top sails and Courses, Carpenter Employed Shaping a Leak under the Starboard Bow, have new jibs helms

Thursday Dec 31st Begins with a strong breeze from S.E. and cloudy weather, Middle part heading South Latter part steering West wind East with clear weather Carpenter Repairing a Leak about the fore Afton web hauled

Friday Jan 1st Begins with a fresh breeze from East and clear, steering S.W. at sundown shortened sail and hauled on the wind for the night, at daylight made sail and put off S.W. to S.E.

Saturday Jan 2nd First part a fresh breeze from S.E. and cloudy with Rain at times, steering S.E., Middle and Latter parts like the first web hauled
Lat by D.R. 28.15 South

Sunday Jan 3rd Begins with a moderate breeze from N.W. and heavy weather steering S.E., Middle part wind from West, Latter part wind S.W. steering S.E.

Monday Jan 4th Begins with a light breeze from S.W. and cloudy, steering S.E., Middle part, Calm Latter part a light breeze from S.W. and clear ship heading S.E., Carpenter Employed Repairing the Starboard Boat, web hauled

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Tuesday Jan 5th First part a fine breeze from N.W. and clear steering South with all sail set Middle and Latter parts strong breezes with Rain at times

Saturday Jan 9th First part a moderate breeze from W.S.W. and pleasant weather, Middle part under easy sail, Latter part heading S.W. with all sail Employed at different jobs about the Rigging,

Sunday Jan 10th Moderate winds and heavy weather throughout heading to the South & West wind from W.S.W. Middle part under easy sail, have new Main top sail Hails and

Monday Jan 11th First part a moderate breeze from W.S.W. and clear, heading S.W. at sundown shortened sail for the night, latter part wind from S.W. heading S.E., web hauled saw 3 Sunfish and some Kelp

Tuesday Jan 12th first part a light breeze from S.W. and clear, heading S.E. at sundown shortened sail for the night Latter part light airs from North, heading S.W. Carpenter Employed Stopping a leak by head knees and Calking the remains of the Starboard Boat
