Thursday April 15th first part a moderate breeze from E by S, and Cloudy, steering N by E. Middle part squally ~ Latter part a fresh breeze from E by S, heading N by E. Obs Lat 9.52 N Long by Chron 30.56

Friday April 16th first part a fine breeze from East and Clear, heading N by E. Middle and Latter parts heading N by E, by N. Employed Taring down the Rigging, wet hauls. Obs Lat 7.42 N Long by Chron 29.53 W

Saturday April 17th first part a fine breeze from E by S and Cloudy, heading N by E. Middle and Latter parts like the first Employed as yesterday. Obs Lat 5.42 South

Sunday April 18th a fine breeze from East and Clear pleasant weather throughout, Ship heading N by E & S, saw 3 Ships one bound North the other South. Obs Lat 3.26 N Long by Chron 30.26 W

Monday April 19th first and Middle parts a moderate Breeze from East and Cloudy, heading N by E. Latter part squally with Rain at times heading North. A brig in sight heading North, Employed washing ship. Obs Lat 1.42 South

Tuesday April 20th light breezes from E to S E and squally. At times, steering North Employed cleaning ship &c. Obs Lat 00.08 S. Long by Chron 30.08 W

Wednesday April 21st first part a light breeze from S E & S and Cloudy, at 5 p.m. put off N.W. by N. Middle and Latter parts wind variable and squally saw a brig heading Northward, wet hauls. Obs Lat 00.53 North

Thursday April 22nd Light airs from N E by E and Clear weather throughout, steering N.W. by N. Employed cleaning the Berms and priming the Bulwarks and Rails. Obs Lat 1.53 N Long by Chron 34.04 W

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Friday April 23rd first part light airs from N E, and Clear. Steering N.W. by N. Middle part like the first Latter part light Showers of Rain at times Employed blacking topsail sheets Anchors. Bobstays &c wet hauled. Obs Lat 2.50 N Long by Chron 35.30 West

Saturday April 24th first and Middle parts a light breeze from N E and Cloudy, steering N.W. Latter part wind variable Employed cleaning the outside. Obs Lat 3.52 North

Sunday April 25th first part wind variable and squally with Rain, course N.W. Middle and Latter like the first. Obs Lat 5.12 N. Long by Chron 38.20 West

Monday April 26th first part a fresh breeze from N E and squalls at times, heading N.W. by N. Middle and Latter strong trades and Cloudy Employed variously Carpenter Repairing the Sparrier Gaff and Mast, wet hauls. Obs Lat 6.56 N. Long by Chron 41.05 West

Tuesday April 27th first part fresh trades from N E and Cloudy, heading N.W. by N, saw a shoal of Blackfish hauled by gill nets. Middle and Latter parts Clear. Obs Lat 8.55 N Long by Chron 44.00

Wednesday April 28th fresh trades from N E and Clear Ship heading N.W. saw a Barque steering S.W. Employed cleaning and blacking the Sparrier whaling Craft, wet hauls. Obs Lat 10.52 N Long by Chron 46.52 West

Thursday April 29th Moderate trades from N E and Clear weather, heading N.W. Employed yesterday. No Observation, Lat by Chron 12.20 North

Friday April 30th Moderate winds from East and Clear weather steering North, Employed painting the Starboard side & washing and scabbing the Landward side. Obs Lat 13.48 N Long by Chron 42.26 West
