Sunday May 2nd first and middle parts a light breeze from E to S^E and Rain at times, steering N^W by W. Latter part clear and a steady breeze from S^E,

Monday May 3rd first part a moderate breeze from S^E and clear steering N^W by W. Middle and Latter parts like the first Employed blacking the Larboard side, saw a ship heading N^W.

Tuesday May 4th first part a moderate breeze from East and clear, steering N^W by W. Middle and Latter parts like the first Employed painting the Bulwarks &c.

Wednesday May 5th first part a moderate breeze from East and clear, steering N^W. Middle and Latter parts the same Employed painting the waterways and whitewashing the Steerage and Forecastle.

Thursday May 6th first part a fine breeze from N^E and cloudy, steering N^W. Middle and Latter parts like the first. Employed whitewashing between Decks and painting the quarter Boats &c.

Friday May 7th first part a fine breeze from N^E and clear weather, steering N^W by W. Middle and Latter parts Wind from East and cloudy steering N^W. Employed whitewashing between Decks and painting the waist-boat.

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Saturday May 8th first part a moderate breeze from S^E and cloudy weather, steering N^W. Middle and Latter parts like the first Employed variously.

Sunday May 9th first and middle parts a fresh breeze from S^E and cloudy, steering N^W by W. Latter part a fresh breeze from S^E and cloudy steering N^W. Ship looking about 150 strokes per hour, saw a Brig N. and a 3 masted schooner steering West.

Monday May 10 first part a fresh breeze from S^E and dark cloudy weather, steering N^W by W. Middle part squally with the wind from West and Rain, thunder and lightning heading N^W. Latter part calm and clear, wet hauled

Tuesday May 11th first part calm and clear at midnight got a light breeze from N^E, Latter part heading N^W by W. Employed painting the Lower mast and other necessary places aloft passed a Barque steering Northward wet hauled

Wednesday May 12th A light breeze from East and cloudy weather, steering N^W by W. Saw a ship steering about North, Employed variously. Wet hauled
