Monday Dec. 31st 1855 Fresh breeze and fair weather. Saw a bark. Lat. 7. 30 S. Lon. 9. 15 E.

Tuesday Jan. 1st 1856 Fine breeze and pleasant weather. Water very dark. Seeing sail N.W. Lat. 6. 40 S. Lon. 8. 30 E.

Wednesday Jan. 2nd Moderate breeze and fine weather. Spoke the bark Milnet. Lat. 6. 55 S. Lon. 7. 45 E.

Thursday Jan. 3rd Fresh breeze and pleasant weather. Lat. 7. 03 S. Lon. 8. 40 E.

Friday Jan. 4th Fine breeze and pleasant weather. Caught one blackfish. Lat. 7. 13 S. Lon. 8. 55 E.

Saturday Jan. 5th Fresh breeze and cloudy. Lat. 7. 32 S. Lon. 10. 00 E.

Sunday Jan. 6th Pleasant breeze and fair weather. Saw a bark. Seeing N.W. Lat. 7. 43 S. Lon. 11. 37 E.

Monday Jan. 7th First part fresh breeze, latter part light airs and pleasant weather. Lat. 8. 00 S. Lon. 11. 30 E.

Tuesday Jan. 8th Moderate breeze and fair weather. At daylight saw the coast, stood in 40 fathoms 2 miles dist. Lat. 7. 31 S. Lon. 12. 30 E.

Wednesday Jan. 9th 1856 Light breeze and fair weather. Seeing N.W. Lat. 7. 15 S. Lon. 11. 25 E.

Thursday Jan. 10th First part light winds and fair, latter part cloudy. Lat. 6. 52 S. Lon. 10. 15 E.

Friday Jan. 11th First part light breeze, latter fresh, and fair weather. Saw a bark & brig, the former cutting. Lat. 6. 18 S. Lon. 8. 47 E.

Saturday Jan. 12th Moderate breeze and fine weather. Spoke the Milnet. Lat. 6. 43 S. Lon. 8. 55 E.

Sunday Jan. 13th Fine breeze and fair weather. Saw 3 sails. Lat. 7. 12 S. Lon. 8. 42 E.

Monday Jan. 14th Light breeze and fine weather. Spowed down 1 Bl. oil. Bent new N.E. Gallant sail and bent down forward. Lat. 7. 21 S. Lon. 10. 25 E.

Tuesday Jan. 15th Fresh breeze and fair weather. Employed making staysail of Mainmast. Seeing N.W. Lat. 6. 41 S. Lon. 9. 20 E.

Wednesday Jan. 16th Fine breeze and pleasant weather. Saw & caught 3 porpoises. Lat. 6. 06 S. Lon. 13. 35 E.
