 with fine breeze and hazy weather

 acted as cook since Feb. 1st to this date and is
 entitled to pay as the same. ^{Lat. 8.02 S.}
 Wednesday July 2nd Fresh breeze and hazy. Saw
 1 sail. Bent jib ^{Lat. 7.58 S.}
 Thursday July 3rd Moderate breeze and pleasant
 weather ^{Lat. 7.45 S.}
 Friday July 4th Light breeze the first part, latter
 part calm and hazy ^{Lat. 8.01 S.}
 Saturday July 5th Light air and hazy. Spoke
 the Milenoket ^{Lat. 8.06 S.}
 Sunday July 6th Fine breeze and clear with
^{Lat. 7.33 S.}
 Monday July 7th Fine breeze and fair. At 6 A.M.
 saw 4 sch. wh. lower in company with the
 Milenoket, got a wh. apiece ^{Lat. 7.11 S.}
 22 ^{Long. 14.00 E.}
