Calm & light air Lat. 9. 58 S. Long. 11. 47 E.

Fine breeze and hazy Lat. 11. 08 S. Long. 11. 26 E.

Monday Sept. 15th

Pleasant breeze and fine weather Lat. 11. 04 S. Long. 9. 16 E.

Tuesday Sept. 16th

First part fresh breeze, latter part light with some showers Lat. 11. 33 S. Long. 7. 43 E.

Wednesday Sept. 17th

Light breeze and cloudy Heavy swell from S. W. Lat. 10. 22 S. Long. 6. 46 E.

Thursday Sept. 18th

Moderate breeze and cloudy. Saw a badger steering S. E. Lat. 10. 35 S. Long. 5. 44 E.

Fine breeze and fair weather At 8 A.M. saw the island of St. Helena bearing N. N. W. At 6 P.M. luffed for of the S. E. of the island dist 5 miles Lat. 16. 02 S.

Strong breeze. At daylight kept away for the anchorage, at 8 A.M. anchored in 15 fms. at Lamutown
