

Journal of a voyage in the Atlantic

Sunday Nov 18th 1856

Commenced with fine breezes from E. Middle and latter part light breezes and some rain Course N.W. by E. Lat by D. R. 21. 33 N. Lon. 46. 13 W.

Monday Nov 19th

Commenced calm Middle and latter part light breeze from E. S. Saw 3 sails Lat by D. R. 19. 33 N. Lon. 46. 34 W.

Tuesday Nov 20th

From N.E. Fine breezes, and fair weather Course N.W. by N. Lat by D. R. 21. 03 N. Lon. 47. 53 W.

Wednesday Nov 21st

Light air from rain Course N.W. Lat by D. R. 21. 39 N. Lon. 49. 56 W.

Thursday Nov 22nd

First part light air from S. Ends with fine breeze from N.W. Course N.W. Lat by D. R. 22. 17 N. Lon. 51. 47 W.

Friday Nov 23rd

First part fine breezes from N.W. from T.P.M. so 9 baffling & squally, ends with fresh breeze from N. Steering by the wind to the S. Lat by D. R. 22. 53 N. Lon. 52. 07 W.

Saturday Nov 24th

Strong breezes from N. to E. and squally. By the wind to the S. Lat by D. R. 24. 00 N. Lon. 54. 26 W.

Ocean on board bark Tropic Bird of N. Bedford

Sunday Nov 25th

Strong breezes & heavy squalls. Handed T. G. Sails & single reefed topsails Course N.W. Three from N. to E. Lat by D. R. 24. 56 N. Lon. 56. 15 W.

Monday Nov 26th

Commenced with strong breezes from N. to E. Middle & latter part light baffling air from N. to E. Split M. Sail, and lost head sail. Steering by the wind Lat by D. R. 25. 27 N. Lon. 57. 15 W.

Tuesday Nov 27th

Light baffling air and calms Lat by D. R. 25. 30 N. Lon. 58. 20 W.

Wednesday Nov 28th

Light air from N. and fair weather Lat by D. R. 26. 07 N. Lon. 58. 40 W.

Thursday Nov 29th

Light N. air and fair weather Lat by D. R. 26. 26 N. Lon. 59. 00 W.

Friday Nov 30th

Light N. air & fair weather. Saw 2 sails. Lat by D. R. 26. 13 N. Lon. 59. 40 W.

Saturday Dec 1st

Light air & calms. Saw a ship Lat by D. R. 26. 17 N. Lon. 59. 00 W.
