 Long 77:44 and low 1° low fish low the boat and caught
 the 75 he was very large and 1° 1/2 fish
 filled in behind so ends with the boat cutting
 him up to get some out for supper and no
 whales but a strong current setting to 11°
 so ends with light rain of inflammation and strong
 breeze of calculation No more heard all times
 Wednesday 20th Began with fresh breeze from N.E. Shaving
 Lat 1:40 11° 11 PM from 11° and 12° the first moderate and
 Long 11:10 No nothing except porpoises and a strong wind
 Chances of nothing to the Northward No ends the day
 Thursday 21st Fine pleasant weather and moderate wind
 Lat 3:06 11° and low nothing except 2 porpoises and strong
 Long 11:48 11° 11 PM at the current setting to N.E. East
 of Chances of continuity of fair weather strong gulls of
 discontentment and gulls of discouragement to 11°
 Friday 22nd Strong breeze from N.E. Shaving on
 Lat 3:36 the wind at 11 AM with fine weather
 Long 11:58 and 1° Northwesterly current No nothing with the
 Saturday 23rd Fine weather from S.E. Shaving S.W.
 Lat 3:30 11° and low nothing except porpoises ship
