 Let Chapman thing
 after his being
 taken to the
 ship
 Monday
 I had from Monday
 at the place
 But not from there

Shift at Redder Bay
 Employed in Supervising and at 3 PM
 Chapman took his clothes and Bag there
 up and put them in to the Boat in honor
 to the Capt and when the boat went on shore
 he put in to them and in a few minutes
 of the land he took horse in company
 with the man that brought down the man
 and ship and took his provisions from the
 man taking up to the house below boat house
 during dinner in the afternoon
 then employed in Supervising Bread and Flour
 between shells and at 4 PM Chapman returned
 to the ship with his man and he put back of his
 bag Lutter post I watch on shore and come of
 I mean nothing to catch a person there
 except and I thought handles and a few guns
 then I put post I watch on shore and
 at night they all came of except Heston
 and John Foster and they were each
 to the ship and the Capt went ashore
 in the evening and found the Spanish Litterman
 20 dollars to catch the 2 men to him Lutter post
 got of 100 lbs of water to 2 men with no intention
 of this I put post the 2 men went on shore
 with a view to have of a raft and one of
 our Sandwich Island natives did not behave just
 right and he struck him and the British
 picked in to him and I went with his house
 but Mr W turned him and after a smart quarrel
 got the upper hand but went to his limit
 at 10 PM finished all men went in this place
 Lutter post got of 3 bullocks and had shot
 and got some for feed and at 11 PM the
 Bullock Boat came in and the men were
 that went after our men and gave up the
 chase did not like to follow them

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Left Redder Bay and P.H.B
 First post the Victory and Phoenix Boats
 came in and at 4 PM took the anchor and
 stood out and soon saw the 3 ships and then
 of 1 3 through the night in company with
 the 2 ships and have left with the loss of
 a gun man & hand of Maps & sundries mistaking
 from the Fisher that says on shore there
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
