Part of Mexico

Monday 2nd Strong wind from S. & S.W. 18-25
 Lt 4-46 with a hard beat - sea and the ship
 L 99-00 Looking about 90 or 100. No fish seen
 have to end have nothing except fuel

Tuesday 3rd Calm with moderate wind from
 Lt 6-32 S. & S.W. 18-25 and the water empty
 L 98-21 in fresh water turning Marshall and mangrove
 land heads out of Lagoon and S.W. 18-25
 latter part moderate wind from S. & S.W. 18-25
 S. to end have nothing

Wednesday 4th Moderate wind from S. & S.W.
 Lt 4-48 S. & S.W. latter part the same and have nothing
 L 99-09 to break the face of the beam to end

Thursday 5th East moderate wind from S. & S.W. 18-25
 Lt 4-09 S. & S.W. and S.W. for Black fish
 L 99-00 but did not get any to end the
 moderate and latter part light wind from
 S. & S.W. 18-25 with torrents of rain

Friday 6th Calm with light wind from
 Lt 7-00 N. & N.W. 18-25 with thick steamy weather
 L 99-00 and a quantity of rain. The latter part
 Calm with rain. This day the Captain
 this day & Cannon & turner & monitor and I finished
 finished a standing job & rewriting the 3rd vol.
 standing journal of the voyage up 18 months
 latter part the rain came down in showers

Saturday 7th Calm with moderate wind
 Lt 9-16 from N. & N.W. 18-25 with continued
 L 96-28 signal of rain latter part the same
 to end the day with 80000

About the Equator

Monday 2nd Calm with a light breeze
 Lt 00-06 from N. & N.W. 18-25 with not much
 L 95-34 being and latter part calm in
 light showers of rain to end with nothing

Tuesday 3rd Calm with light wind from S. & Middle
 Lt 1-56 latter part light wind from S. and S.W. 18-25
 L 95-19 with not much hopes of action, out of S.W. 18-25
 wind and calm at present to end

Wednesday 4th Calm with light wind from
 Lt 0-50 S. to S.W. and S.W. 18-25 with
 L 94-15 torrent showers of rain. Middle and
 latter part the same to end

Thursday 5th Calm with moderate wind
 Lt 0-09 from S. & S.W. 18-25 with rain
 L 90-00 and gust at sundown saw a flock of
 the weather sea down and saw the back
 her main top sail for us to run down
 but it was late and in the morning
 saw 2 sails saw a part of the weather down latter
 part last light of the 2 ships and to end
 with a continued rain fog and mist

Friday 6th Moderate wind from S. & S.W. 18-25
 Lt 0-03 latter part showers of rain latter part
 L 92-40 calm with rain and saw nothing
 and empty in nothing to end
