

March 1894 About the Islands

Saturday 8th Commences calm with Charles
Lat 2-40 Islands of the weather beam about
17 miles Dis latter part light
Log 40-99 of the land and low ground to E.

Sunday 9th Commences calm with nothing
Lat 38-40 in light and a strong westerly current
Log 90-00 latter part a light breeze from
N.W. and then by the wind at 8 P.M.

Monday 10th Commences with Madras winds
Lat 4-46 from N.W. & then by the wind
Log 87-55 at 8 P.M. and low water to E.

Tuesday 11th Commences with Madras winds
Lat 5-00 and 8 P.M. latter part the sun
Log 88-12 and low water and found
the current strong to the eastward

Wednesday 12th Commences with Madras winds
Lat 6-00 from N.W. & at 1 P.M. low
Log 88-12 Blackish and low tide 3 Boats and
Boats put one and took him in at 1 P.M.
Latter part strong winds from E. then
at 3 P.M. employed in fishing the fish

Thursday 13th Commences with strong winds from
Lat 2-00 E. B. & then at 10 P.M. latter part
Log 89-12 then at 11 P.M. low a light
of the weather and low ground to E.

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Friday 14th Commences with Madras winds
and the 2 Boats in pursuit of the Whales
Lat 1-34 and at 10 P.M. the school came to gether
and started to the windward and the Boats
Log 88-34 came on board at 2 P.M. and at 3 P.M. they
milled to the N.W. and then crossed a
line of Boats and continued the chase with the
school and ship and came within a short
distance of them but they were ungrateful
as they left the boat and the side went up
towards the N.W. and headed it through the night
to E. and Friday with an error

Saturday 15th Commences as Friday and low tide with
Lat 1-23 light air through the night and in the
morning the whales and came all
Log 88-51 3 Boats and took them gently but they
were so wild that we could not get in
to them and took up the Boats and
the whales were sent out at light
and at 4 P.M. low the land bearing
at 10 P.M. and commenced boiling water
and looking out for the whales and killed a few
millions to E. and this day all well

Sunday 16th Commences calm with 3 Boats in light
Lat 1-23 and at 3 P.M. low a light air and the school
Log 88-51 and headed N.W. through the night
and in the morning the 3 Boats and
2 of them were killed and 3 of them were
killed and all hands were present of the
and at 4 P.M. a Boat came on board from
one of the ships and found one of them to
be the Whales and 16 months out with 3 of the
and 1 of the 7 months out with 3 of the
the school ships rather a poor prospect
