

July 1834 Off Shore Ground

Monday 29th Continued quarter and W. 2nd ship
4-15 and Landed all 3 Boats and the north
Boat then M. and the whole two to wing
to the Western and the 2 Boats pursued
him and after pursuing to him who in
a 1st the 2 Boats came up with him
with power of the king with power
in them abouts and turned him up and
took him along side at 12 past 12 o'clock
and found he had 8 of the Ship Landed
those in him and has been here of the
Low Beam cutting to End this Day

Monday 30th Commenced with fresh trades and Embled
in the morning under the North Star and
at 8 P.M. hauled on and commenced cutting and
put the head cutting much as by hand
and then hauled up the night later part
finished cutting to End

Tuesday July 31st First boat got the first red
at 1000 and at London the Lowest Crossed over there
and the 2nd boat came and passed and put his
Log 000 P.M. he had 4 Whales and found one
and has lost 6 Blubber with him and
Landed later part lost light of him to End

Wednesday 1st First boat Employed in Baiting and
at 1000 found 16 lb of oil and the other boat
later part finished Baiting about 10 o'clock
Log 000 and put away for Baiting to End

Thursday 2nd First boat Employed in Baiting
at 3-36 later part Employed in Baiting and then
Log 000 down in the fore hole to End this Day

Friday 3rd First boat - Gentle - 1/3 trades heading
at 3-16 to it again Eastern and the Ship under the
Log 000 tail Employed in Baiting again and
at night more ship to the 1st and Western
later part the same to End with repair
1001 Barrels of oil on 1st in Day the 3rd

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Thursday July 4th First boat Gentle - 1/3 trades
at 4 P.M. finished Baiting down at 3
Log 000 Whales making about 220 lb and washed
the Ship for the 4th of July 10 and mist
Log 000 spent more at head and I hope to
employ the next in summer if it is possible
later part Employed in making and then
Boat to End this Day

Friday 5th Commenced with strong S.E. trades
at 4-38 heading to the 1st and Eastern and has
Log 000 been for to the wind and all hands
Employed in washing oil to the 1st later
part to End this Day

Monday 6th The fine trades and the Ship under
at 5-15 all sail to north to the Eastern and has
Log 000 for to the Western to End this Day

Tuesday 7th First boat fine trades and heading
at 6-00 all sail with the north Employed in
Log 000 washing the Ship for the 1st is coming all
the morning later part all hands

Wednesday 8th Commenced with brisk trades and the
at 5-26 the under all sail heading to the 1st
Log 000 and the north Employed in Baiting
later part the same to End

Thursday 9th Commenced with Moderate S.E. trades
at 6-04 heading to the 1st and nothing in sight
Log 000 later part the same to End

Friday 10th Commenced with Moderate S.E. trades
at 4-44 heading by the wind at S.E. and all hands
Log 000 Employed in Baiting nothing and the
Boat and then Landed down and had
later part fine weather and 2 fine chances to
Log 000 saw the 1st from mast head later part
