

July 1884 Off Shore Ground

Thursday 16th Commenced with Madras trades and the ship under all sail to get to the Eastern
At 0:02 it was the latter part of Saturday that
Log 112-49 was the Madras 1 Boats and Embarked
its machinery is under care to end

Friday 17th Commenced with Madras trades and the ship under all sail to get to the Eastern
At 0:34 By the wind at 8 N E and at 1/2 past
10 more were seen towards which and at
1/2 past we saw a large 2 Boats of
Whales and at 2 P M saw all 3 Boats
and pursued them until sundown but
this was very small whales and so at
11 P M that the Boats could not get on
so took up the Boats and put them
down through the night under short sail
and at 8 O'Clock in the morning saw them
again and pursued all 3 Boats and they
and killed 3 young Bull whales and we
got them alive and about one dead
with one more very much injured and
brought all the ship for haul of Herring here
By the Capt's first whale 10 ends

Saturday 18th The British wind and employed in cutting
At 0:00 and finished cutting the 3 at 4 P M and the
Log 0:00 put Embarked in cutting up, saw the other
Log 0:00 put got the first under way to end

Sunday 19th The British S E trades and the ship
At 0:00 heading to the S and Eastern Employed in
Log 0:00 Building and Lumbering out for home

Monday 20th The British S E trades and the ship
At 0:00 heading to the S and Eastern Employed in
Log 0:00 Building and Lumbering out for home

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Thursday 16th Commenced with Madras trades and the ship under all sail to get to the Eastern
At 7:24 By the wind at 8 N E and at 1/2 past
Log 0:00 2 Boats of the Le Bois and went for them
Log 0:00 Latter part Employed in cutting and
Lumber in the after hold to end

Friday 17th Commenced with Madras trades and the ship under short sail and all hands
At 7:24 Employed in cutting and Lumbering
Lumber Latter part the same and in the morning
Log 112-25 8 and 10 of us were employed in mauling
10 lb bulk of oil up to the wind and we
got it about 1/2 way up and the ship made
a haul and the Le Bois and they began
to give away from behind it and we
were left behind the Le Bois and took for
2 giving 10 lb of butter for a 1 lb
butter, I saw about the ship and grain to end

Saturday 18th The British wind and employed in cutting
At 8:35 of the same and all went to the S E
Log 0:00 and saw nothing later part the same to end

Sunday 19th The British S E trades and the ship
At 5:36 Latter part the same to end to end this day
Log 0:00

Monday 20th Commenced with Madras S E trades
At 5:34 By the wind at 8 E first part
Log 113-00 I was taken from the ship
and Lumber and in the morning saw Whales
and saw all 3 Boats and the latter were put
past and turned up a 30 lb whale and the
2 other Boats got first to a 40 lb whale but
no run the 2nd over the Churn and then sent
them that we have for 3rd mates to help
him and he got up to him and a chance
to kill him but missed him of course and
seemed to get all 3 Boats spoke so we lost
him by having such irregularities
