

Oct 1834 About the Marquesas

Monday 8th Commenced with the Santa Lucia
and then M B L and I at 4 P.M.
Left 100 for the Land bearing S B W and at
5 P.M. saw the Island of Rookwood
bearing West and the Island of Lincolne
bearing S and then M B L from the
South end of Rookwood at 10 P.M.
S B L and at 11 P.M. it might
be seen coming to the Land and
at 12 M. the main ship left also the
smaller vessel and then M B L from
the Northern side of the Island and
saw Nukuhiva bearing M B L about
3 miles distant and at 4 P.M. saw
a few of the Savages coming out to us
and we fired at them and took them on
board then had brought the 1st of a cargo
made and some goods to the shore for
some high and white teeth and then
informed us that they had a black dog
boys and some girls they would dispose
of for muskets and cloth and we had
a boat to go and bring of and in

Thursday 9th Commenced with the Santa Lucia
and then M B L and I at 4 P.M. the boat
returned with 2 boys and a few coconuts
and made sail for Nukuhiva and
were upsit of the harbor at 4 P.M.
in the morning we saw a boat
and went in and found all the white
men that we had left here had gone
and they had more of the muskets
and we found a white man here and
a quantity of potatoes and we took some
with the boat and went out in the
boat and went out in the boat and

the boat was in the harbor
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Oct 1834 Leaving Nukuhiva

Wednesday 10th Left Nukuhiva at 10 P.M.
with the ship and crew with mail and
provisions and found that the Savages had some
very treacherous here and had killed several
white men and the missionaries about
pillaged by them in Broad daylight
and then had some more than 1000
than 1000 and then we a ship lying
here at the time and we fired at them
and then we took them away and
at night closed the ship of mules
and then the females to remain on
board then we saw the last possible
remedy for the Savages after that
employed in carrying the boat and
sent a boat to the other side for boys.

Thursday 11th Employed in blocking the boats
and paying attention to the women and
sent a boat up to the other side for boys
for boys and she returned at 8 P.M. with
2 boys and some coconuts and provisions
and met with a few Savages this morning
and had a boat loaded with provisions
40 girls and 3 men in her it was a spot
where the girls go there is no dancing
there and they have no desire to fill
nothing more than nature gives them
Employed in getting of potatoes S. L.

Friday 12th At 8 o'clock in the morning M. B. L.
all hands to take the anchor and carry
the girls and then there was some fire
and then the girls for it is not yet that
we must with pleasure as there is some
and wished to improve every moment
with his band that was possible they little
have things that they and more has
as when we have been engaged to hand some
things and went to the other side and then

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
