Thursday Sept. the 4th 104
These 24 hours begins with moderate wind from
the North & fine weather. Beginning towards
the Islands. Mid & Latter Part Light air
see groups.

Friday Sept. the 5th 105
Begins with light wind from NW by the
wind to the NW. brought 7 Sallphim. Mid
Part Strong wind & heavy squalls attended with
rain. about 11 AM to the SE took in fore & mid
top sails. Latter Part Moderated at the top
sails & rain. top gallant sail. At 4 PM
Lat 41.22 N
Long 30.26 W

Saturday Sept. the 6th 106
Commences with moderate wind from NW
at 7 PM Shortened sail & at 11 PM wind to the
West. Mid Part light air. Latter Part
wind set all sail.

Sunday Sept. the 7th 107
Begins with light wind from NW by the
the wind to the wind to the NW at 5 PM
see the Isle of Hawaii bearing NW by N dist 30 miles
Mid Part light air. Latter Part light wind
at 4 PM hauled to the NW at 10 PM the wind
at 11 PM hauled to the SE.

Monday Sept. the 8th 108
Commences with light wind from NW by the
course SE & large swell from the North. Mid
Part light air from the South. Latter Part light wind
from West.

Tuesday the 9th 109
Begins with light air from NW. course SE by E &
Latter Part Moderate wind with rain. at 11 PM fine
lightning attended with rain. at 11 PM fine
weather.

Off the Hawaiian Islands Sept. 151
Wednesday Sept. the 10th 110
Light breeze from SE by N. At 11 AM the Islands of
Rev. Royal St. George & Francisco light bearing from
SE by E. At 1 PM at 1 PM the Islands of Rev. Royal
insight. Mid Part lay off the Isle of Francisco
Latter Part land. got No recruits. At 11 PM
went on board. Found the ship wreck.

Thursday the 11th 111
Moderate breeze from the East at 7 PM lay off
& on St. George. see & sail. Latter Part fine
weather at 5 PM went on shore for recruits.

Friday Sept. 12 112
Begins with mild breeze from SE at 7 PM
come on board. Mid Part lay off & on at 10
PM took on board along side the ship. Latter Part
fresh breeze. landed for recruits.

Saturday Sept. 13th 113
Strong breeze from SE. Laying off & on
at 7 PM all on board Mid Part lay off under
Short. at 4 PM heavy fresh of the wind. with
lightning & much rain. at 8 PM
Mid Part Moderate Steered for Hawaii.

Sunday Sept. 14th 114
Strong wind from the South. being too
hurried to land at Hawaii. worked through
the passage Mid Part off from SE part of
the SE part of Hawaii. under. Seeable reefs
Latter Part Moderate at all.

Sunday Sept. 15th 115
Begins with light wind from SE at 7 PM
landed at Hawaii for recruits at 5 PM come
on board. Latter Part fresh breeze at 8 PM
landed at Hawaii & picked recruits.
