116

Tuesday 17th

Light & variable wind from W. & E. toward the
East. Spoke crushed. Discharged 1000 lbs of
Ship's & crew's by name of Mr. Johnson. To
the stores & John Silver. St.

Wednesday Sept 17th

117

begins with strong breeze from the W. & E.
at 5 PM started by the wind East. Middle &
Latter Part. Strong wind blowing East
Sailed 4 PM top sails set

Lat. 34. 56
Long 28. 21.

Thursday Sept 18

118

commences with strong wind from W. & E. St.
by the wind to the S. & E. Middle Part. Strong
breeze. Told in fore & Miz top sails & close the main.
Latter. Slightly.

commences with a gale from W. & E. fitted
to sent a New Main top. sail. at 7 PM St.
W. & E. by compass. Middle & Latter Part. Strong
breeze from W. & E. at 8 PM started ship to the
North. Lat. 40. 20. St. Michael. Dist. 20 miles

Saturday Sept 20th

begins with strong wind from W. & E. at 2
PM set fore & Miz top. sails. at 6 PM started
increased wind ship to the S. & E. took in fore & Miz
top. sails. Middle & Latter Part. Strong wind at 6
PM set fore & Miz top. sails close. Proved. Under
fore sail sent a New one. sent down main top.
gallant. gave to reef. Lat. 37. 16 N
Long 25. 18 W

At 24 hours begins with a fresh. a gale. from
East. sent a New Main top. sail. & started
the yard. one sail insight. at 6 PM St. Marks
Dist. 20 miles extreme. points bearing N to E. & E.
Middle & Latter Part. Strong wind at 11 PM started
Ship to the North. Lat. 36. 25 N

Monday Sept 22nd

122

begins with strong wind from W. & E. at 6 PM
started ship to the S. & E. sent the part. St. Marks
bearing N. & E. Dist. 20 miles. sea 3 sail. Latter
Part. Moderate. set all sail. at 10 PM tacked to the
North. 2 sail insight. Lat.

Tuesday Sept 23rd

123

begins with a fresh breeze from W. & E. at 2
PM tacked to the S. & E. at 6 PM started sail
breeze & sea. 4 sail insight. Middle & Latter
Part. Moderate. at 5 PM set all sail.

Wednesday Sept 24th

124

Moderate wind & fine weather. Cruising off
St. Marks. at 4 PM spoke ship. St.
Michael. Dist. 20 miles. Middle & Latter Part.
Moderate. Strong W. & E. current. Lat. 36. 49 N
Long 24. 42 W

Thursday Sept 25th

125

commences with a fresh breeze from W. & E. at 2
PM started ship to the S. & E. at 6 PM started sail. Middle &
Latter Part. fresh breeze sea 2 sail. there
is no appearance of Whales about. Lat. 36. 43 N
Long 24. 47 W
