

Remarks on board Nov 1st 1862  
Saturday Nov 1st  
bom. with light air & calm. Mid & Latt.  
Part the same. Lat 7.36 N  
Long 19.55 W

Sunday Nov 2nd 163  
At 2 PM a heavy squall from East. raised  
the top sails. At 4 PM moderated set all  
sail. Morning dry with a fresh breeze &  
cloudy. Mid Part. Squally. Latt. light air  
from S.E. & clear weather. Lat 6.20  
Long 19.43

Monday Nov 3rd 164  
bom. with light air & passing squalls of  
rain from the S.E. Mid & Latt. Part. calm.  
Lat 6.00 N

Tuesday Nov 4th 165  
bom. with squalls of rain & variable winds  
at 6 PM calm. cloudy. Mid & Latt. Part.  
the same.

Wednesday Nov 5th 166  
light air & calm. cloudy with some  
rain. see forepoins. Latt. Part. light air  
from S to S.W. tacked & retacked. Lat 5.42 N  
Long 18.45

Thursday Nov 6th 167  
light breeze from S.W. at 11 AM. wind to the  
S.E. at 6 PM passed a French ship. At 11 AM  
Mid & Latt. Part. squalls of rain. No ill

Friday Nov 7th 168  
bom. with light air from the West  
with rain. the ship's bottom very foul  
with blanna makes little or no head way  
in light winds. Mid & Latt. Part. light  
S.W. to W. current setting to the S.W. see  
one fire back. Lat 4.46 N  
Long 17.26 W

Proceed to the South & West  
Saturday Nov 8th 169  
bom. with light wind from S.W. tacked &  
retacked. Mid Part. calm. Latt. light air from  
the South. hauled to the S.W. under fore top.  
Sail to wind. see sail insight. current setting  
to the S.W. at the rate of 1/2 M. per hour. Lat 4.30 N  
Long 16.55 W

Sunday Nov 9th 170  
light air from the South. fine morning &  
breeze fresh top sail. lowered fore black flag  
got home. Mid Part. light wind from S.W. at 4 PM  
a heavy squall of rain. Latt. fine weather  
breeze S.W. Lat 3.35 N  
Long 17.37 W

Monday Nov 10th 171  
light wind from S to S.W. course S.W. by W. Mid  
& Latt. Part. fresh breeze & squally & some rain  
all sail set. see one sail. Lat 2.08 N  
Long 19.27 W

Tuesday Nov 11th 172  
bom. with fresh breeze from S to S.E. at 11 AM  
at 11 AM all sail set. passed the ship. At 11 AM  
Mid the same. Latt. Part. Moderate. passed a brig  
at Morning but hoarse. Lat 1.26 N  
Long 21.57 W 20.50 W

Wednesday Nov 12th 173  
Moderate breeze from S.W. at 11 AM. at 11 AM  
all hands employed in fitting rigging &c. Mid &  
Latt. Part. Moderate. breeze from S.E. head  
up. S.W. Lat 1.55 N  
Long 23.56 W 22.06

Thursday Nov 13th 174  
bom. with fine breeze from S.E. head up.  
at 11 AM. employed in overhauling blocks found them  
in a bad condition. Mid & Latt. Part. fresh  
breeze from S.E. by S to S.E. Lat 2.30 N  
Long 25.59 W  
Long 24.01
