Comm. with light air & calm & cloudy weather. Mid Part calm. Latter Part a fresh breeze from N by E & clearing. see journals

Thursday Nov 27 1887

Comm. with fresh breeze from N to N E & clearing. sea pumbers & 2 sail. at 4 PM tacked to the N N W. Mid & Latter Part fresh breeze see 3 Whaling boats
Lat. 17. 20
Long 35. 20 W

Friday Nov 28th 1887

Strong breeze from N by E. at 11 AM tacked to the N N W. sea pumbers & 2 sail. Mid & Latter Part the same.
Lat. 18. 15
Long 36. 36 W

Sat. Nov 29th 1887

Comm. with fresh breeze from N E. at 11 AM tacked to the South. sea 2 sail. Mid & Latter Part the same.
Lat. 19. 58
Long 38. 50 W

Sunday Nov 30th 1887

Comm. with moderate breeze from E N E. Calm. South. at 5 PM spoke for Cape. While day hauled 6 mths 70 lbs. Mid & Latter Part fine breeze from N E. Lat. 24. 57

Monday Nov Dec 1st 1887

Fresh breeze from N E. at 11 AM tacking sails & hauled. Mid Part the same. Latter & the wind hauled to the N N W. Strong in squalls took sail. Learn to handle reef

Thursday Dec 2nd 1887

The wind increased to a gale took in 1st & 2nd top sails. Mid Part more moderate. Set the top sails back. reefed Latter Part set all sail.

Friday Dec 3rd 1887

Comm. with fresh breeze from the South. at 11 AM tacked to the N N W. spoke the ship. hauled 3 mths. clear. Latter Part fresh breeze from N E. at 5 PM tacked to the N E. Emp. in. Mid Part sail.

Long 36. 55 W

Thursday Dec 4th 1887

Comm. with fresh breeze from N N W. at 11 AM tacked to the N E. part main top sail. The Mid Part tacked & retacked Latter Part squally. at 11 AM tacked to the West.
Lat. 25. 09
Long 36. 45 W

Friday Dec 5th 1887

Moderate wind from N N W. at 11 AM tacked to the West. one sail in sight. Mid Part light wind. Latter Part light air.
Lat. 25. 07
Long 37. 24 W

Saturday Dec 6th 1887

Comm. with light wind from N E. at 11 AM spoke for Cape. hauled 6 mths 70 lbs. Mid & Latter Part the same. hauled 6 mths 70 lbs. see journals
Lat. 26. 35
Long 38. 33 W

Sunday Dec 7th 1887

Comm. with fresh breeze from N E. at 11 AM tacking sails & hauled. Mid & Latter Part strong wind. paper a ship. under North sail.
Lat. 28. 37
Long 41. 25 W

Monday Dec 8th 1887

Begins with a moderate breeze from N E. at 11 AM spoke a schooner. see journals. Mid Part light air. Latter Part fresh breeze from N E. at 5 PM tacked to the N N W. cloudy & hazy weather. the butty in sight.
No 145 this day
