Saturday March 25th

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Off the Island of Kure. begins with light air from
 N.W. & calm. St. 6 P.M. the land dist. 5 miles. extreme
 points bearing N.W. by N. a light breeze from the
 land & off to the N.W. by N. Mid Part calm. Latter Part
 light wind from N.W. St. 11 P.M. anchored at Hiloe
 16 ships at anchor. got under way. some used to a
 few lbs of sweet potatoes. the St. got underway
 from Hiloe for Moore to recruits &c

Sunday April the 1st

At 3 P.M. anchored at Hiloe. 14 ships at anchor
 painted ships. finished recruiting. Will remain
 on to learn from St. Officer. Selected ship for a
 man by the name of Gilbert. Were as St. Officer. &
 a native by name of Tom. Here.

April 1st sailed from Moore bound to
 Kahoe. Reached for letters at 12th touched at Honolulu

April 13th

Moderate breeze at 3 P.M. sailed from Honolulu
 Steered N.W. by compass St. all. Leaving sail
 Lat. Part painted Lat. to West. Lat. 19.59 N
