 fore sail set. Mid & Lath kept the same.
 Bar. 29.08 Lat. 45.55 N

Tuesday the 12th 35.5
 Comm. with fresh gale from the West head.
 to the North. Light breeze. Main top sail.
 fore sail & mid top sails close reefed. The wind
 hauled to the West set. mid sail. Lat. the wind W
 course. N.W. sent a new fore top sail.

Wednesday May 13th 35.6
 begins with fresh breeze from N.E. & some
 snow at 3 PM. wind to the North & clear.
 At by the wind to the N.W. Mid & Lath. Part
 strong wind. sent a new fore top. M. May sail.
 Bar. 29.09 Lat. 49.14 N
 Long 171.35 E

Friday May 14th 35.7
 begins with strong breeze from N.W. & by the
 wind to the North. M. Part head up. N.W.
 Lath Part wind to the South breeze N.W. by N
 Bar. 29.07 Lat. 49.20
 Long 171.35 E

Saturday May 15th 35.8
 begins with light breeze from N.E. & course
 N.W. by N. Mid & Lath. Part strong breeze. took
 in light sails. some snow & rain. Lat. 51.00
 Bar. 29.98 Long 169.01 E

Sunday May 16th 35.9
 begins with moderate wind from N.W. & clear.
 weather. at 3 PM. took to the N.E. Lath. Part.
 the wind N.W.
 Bar. 29.90 Lat. 52.02
 Long 169.06 E

Monday May 17th 36.0
 Comm. with light breeze from N.W. & course N. all
 sail set. at 6 AM. sec. light. whales lowered 3
 times fore. them being very wild. could not
 fasten. Lat. 52.10 N
 Long 169.10 E

Tuesday May 18th 36.1
 Comm. with moderate wind from the South &
 fine weather. course N.W. at 3 PM. sec. light.
 whales going quick to the surface. Lat. 4 AM
 sec. light. Island bearing West. Lat. 20 miles
 Bar. 29.60 Lat. 55.04 N

Wednesday May 19th 36.2
 Comm. with light air. from N.E. & snowing
 temp. in setting up. North. Mid & Lath. Part
 calm. sec. grasses. Lat. 55.31
 Bar. 29.70 Long

Thursday May 20th 36.3
 Comm. with light wind from N.W. head to the
 N.E. Mid & Lath. Part light air. from the
 North. Temp. in setting up. North. Lat. 56.34 N

Friday May 21th 36.4
 Comm. with light air. from N.E. head to the
 N.W. Mid Part. the wind N. Lath. Part. sec. 6
 ships are chasing whales. At. M. took
 sec. a large number of fin backs. Lat. 57.22
 Bar. 29.60 Long 169.18

Sat. May 22th 36.5
 Comm. with light wind from N.W. & clear weather.
 head to the N.E. at 4 AM. sec. a ship. sailing
 at 11 AM. lowered fore. a. lower head & struck
 him. Many fin backs in sight. Lat. 58.40 N
 Long 168.20 E
