 These 24 hours begins with moderate wind from N.W. & by 8 PM tacked to the S.E. & 19 ships in sight. Lat. 61.15
 W. 24 see 36 ships & sailing Lat. 61.15
 Bar. 29.80 Long 178 50 E

Monday June 7th 381
 Comm. with light wind from W. & by 8 PM foggy Lat. 61.15
 Lat. 61.15 foggy & ships in sight.

Tuesday June 8th 382
 Comm. with light wind & calm & thick weather. Spoke ship, champion. Mid. part see a number of whales going quick. Lat. 61.15
 Bar. 29.90

Wednesday June 9th 383
 Strong breeze from N.W. & by 8 PM Lat. 61.15
 fine weather. Cruising about the ice & 4 ships sailing Lat. 61.06
 Bar. 29.70

Thursday June 10th 384
 Begins with light wind from N.W. & by 8 PM Lat. 61.15
 lay back. Lat. 61.15 fog cleared see ships in every direction.

Friday June 11th 385
 Begins with fresh breeze from N.W. steering different courses about the ice. Mid. Lat. 61.15
 part strong wind from the south with rain & fog lay on different tack about the ice

Saturday June 12th 386
 Comm. with fresh gale from the south. Thick & raining weather. sail. N.W. standing on 6 hours tack.

Cruising about the ice.

Sunday June 13th 387
 Begins with moderate wind from the West. Lat. 61.15
 sail. & by 8 PM see the land bearing from N.W. to N.E. 11 ships in sight. Lat. 61.15
 shortened sail. Lat. 61.15 sail. & by 8 PM see the land see whales lowered 3 times with no success. Thick weather.

Monday June 14th 388
 Comm. with thick & rainy weather. Lowered for whales could not find. Whales going to the N.E. Lat. 61.15
 & by 8 PM & 11 ships bearing N.W. Lat. 61.15
 lowered & struck. Lat. 61.15 took the whale to the ship & began to cut. Lat. 61.15 lowered again & struck. Lat. 61.15 took the whale to the ship. finished cutting the first.

Tuesday June 15th 389
 These 24 hours fine weather wind N.W. Mid. part. Lat. 61.15
 began to sail. Lat. 61.15 part. Lat. 61.15 in the other. Lat. 61.15
 whale. Land in sight. Lat. 61.15
 Bar. 29.80

Wednesday June 16th 390
 These 24 moderate wind & foggy see a number of ships sailing.

Thursday 17th 391
 Comm. with fresh breeze from W. & by 8 PM Lat. 61.15
 cleared some the land bearing N. Lat. 61.15
 compass in sailing & steering Lat. 61.15
 Bar. 29.60

Friday June 18th 392
 All these 24 hours foggy weather. sail. in sailing & steering a number of ships in sight.
