begin with a gale from the North. at 6 PM
headed off shore. Lat. 12 miles South. Part. the
same 16 ships insight. Lat. 62. 08

Sunday June 29th

403

begin with a gale from a gale from the N.
see 12 whales too large to lower for them.
South. Part. top. sails close reefed see. a number
of whales & ships

Monday June 30th

404

begin with strong wind & heavy weather. wind
N.W. St. by the wind to the S.E. at 12 M. night.
lowered to the deck. a large whale in the fog
at 1 PM got the whale to the ship. began to kill.
at 8 lowered again with no success

boiling & comm. boiling South. Part. foggy
lowered for. whals with no success
