Thursday Sept. 1st 471
 born... with a fresh breeze from the South.
 Camp in blowing whistles all to no purpose
 whistles going quick to the S.E. & all galled
 at 4 P.M. the wind to the S.E. Mid. Part
 tacked to the westward. Left Port fresh
 breeze. see a number of Mackerels & 2 schools
 of herring at 11 P.M. struck one

Friday Sept. 2nd 472
 born... with strong wind from the S.E.
 & foggy at 8 P.M. took the whole alongside
 at 2 P.M. began to beat at 4 finished work
 in fore & main top sails. headed to the S.E.
 at 4 P.M. strong wind & high sea
 at 4 P.M. headed to the South. see 4 schools going
 quick to the windward. Lat. 68.17

Saturday Sept. 3rd 473
 born... with strong wind from S.E. & hazy
 Camp in blowing fore & main top sails in
 see one school of a M. member of ships
 at 3 P.M. headed to the S.E. Latter Part fresh
 breeze tacked to the South. Camp in blowing

Sunday Sept. 4th 474
 Moderate wind from S.E. & thick. some
 weather. Mid. Part the same. Latter Part
 strong wind from the North. & foggy. at 9
 P.M. finished blowing & born... strong wind

Monday Sept. 5th 475
 Strong wind from the North. & thick
 weather. took in fore & main top sails. headed
 to the westward at 6 P.M. finished blowing
 Latter Part fresh breeze. cloudy & foggy
 at 6 P.M. & main top sails & headed to East.
 Camp in blowing born.

Tuesday Sept. 10th 476
 born... with fresh breeze from the North. &
 cloudy & foggy weather. headed to the westward
 see 4 schools of whistles & several ships. Latter
 Part see one ship & see one school of Mackerels
 of ships in chase. Lat. 68.20 Long 171.20 W

Wednesday Sept. 11th 477
 born... with moderate wind from the N. North.
 & cloudy. took in one broken part. at another
 see one school going quick to the S.E. & chased
 with the Mackerels at 5 P.M. spoke ship Monticello
 Mid. Part at S.E. Latter Part light air from W.W.
 & a thick fog lay with the head sails black.

Thursday Sept. 12th 478
 born... with light air from the W.W. with
 a thick fog lay black. Mid. & Latter Part
 the same

Friday Sept. 13th 479
 born... with light wind from the North.
 & foggy weather. at 6 P.M. spoke ship Price 19
 whistles. see 2 Mackerels. Mid. Part foggy. Latter
 cloudy. spoke the Monticello. Lat. 68.57
 Long 173.39

Saturday Sept. 14th 480
 born... with light air from S.E. & headed to
 the South. Mid. & Latter Part calm & clear
 weather. herring at 11 P.M. with the rest of 4 M.
 p. herring. Lat. 68.54
 Long 174.36

Sunday Sept. 15th 481
 born... with light air from S.E. &
 headed to the Eastward. 9 P.M. in sight
 Mid. & Latter Part light wind. see a number
 of grey whistles. Lat. 68.23
 Long 170.16 W
