Tuesday Oct 19th

Comm. with light wind from N to N E. S. S. E. last. The ship sail & pilot. see a ship. hauled to the S. E. Mid & latter part light & variable wind with passing showers of rain. Temp. in clearing ship inside. see one sail to the S. E. Lat. 28.15 N
 Back 29.10 Long 155.01 W

Wednesday Oct 20th

516

Comm. with light air & variable. Temp. in washing ship outside. at 6 PM a fine breeze from E by S. at 10 PM by compass. Mid part & latter moderate trades from east. Temp. in various parts of ship. Lat 26.26 Long 154.46 by Chrono 154.18

Thursday Oct 21st

517

begins with fresh trades from East. At day break all sail set. Mid & latter part the same. One sail inside. Lat 23.47
 Back 30.10 Long 154.31

Friday Oct 22nd

518

Comm. with strong trades from East. Steering S by E. & all sail set. Mid & latter part strong trades. & some squalls. Lat 21.01
 Long 154.28

Saturday Oct 23rd

519

Comm. with strong trades from E to E by S. At day break. at 5 PM squally trade in. temp. excellent. sails at day E. Mid part strong W by S set the sails. Latter part at 8 PM see the Island of Oahu. Lat 25 miles bearing W by N. last. Chaimski

Sunday Oct 24th

520

Moderate trades from N E. Steering S E. Wind see 3 sail. at 4 PM pilot came on board at 5 PM anchored at Hilo in 49 fathoms 18 ships at anchor

Hilo Oct 1/52

Monday Oct 25th

521

This day Temp. in getting off provisions water. 19 ships at anchor

Tuesday Oct 26

522

This day More S. E. S. E. rain Temp. in getting water

Wednesday Oct 27th

523

Moderate breezes & good weather. Temp. in getting ducks from ship. Minnie. & several from shore at the rate of 10 lbs per bush. There are 111 bush. The ship ready for sea. Geo. A. Welch & Joseph Parker. Departed

Thursday Oct 28th

This day begins with light air & some rain. at 4 PM get under way bound to Oahu at 4 PM fine trades set the sails

Friday Oct 29th

525

Moderate trades. Lat. for Honolulu. at 4 PM light air from the S. E. W. bearing. Dimora point. at 6 PM bearing W by N. Lat 12 miles

Saturday Oct 30th

526

light air from the South. at 5 PM anchored in Honolulu harbor. 130 ships at anchor. Shipped 20.000 lbs of bone for the Thosie for W. B. H. Shipped 5000 lbs of Whale & sperm in Brig. Middle of Boston. Discharged 4th & 3rd Officers & Shipped. Departed for the 4th. Daniel Parker & 3rd Officer. 13 men & my boy. Departed. brought 2 at Honolulu. Welch & Parker. safe in the port. sent from Hilo, on the 20th of Nov sailed from the Honolulu bound to the California Coast. Spent Whaling.

Took Welch, Parker, Atwood, Masquer from the 1st
