Tuesday Feb 8th 595
Comm. with moderate breeze from NW by W
at 3 PM see the 2 whales & 2 small. Whaling
at 6 PM Barometer back. N. by W. 20 m.
Mid & Latter Part. Moderate. at 8 PM see 4 whales
at 9 PM lowered at 1 PM & struck one. lower
to half saved the lower  20

Wednesday Feb 9th 596
Light breeze at 9 PM took the whale to the
ship. one. last. Chasing both in the whale
at 3 PM the Whaler struck. at 4 PM got the
Whale to the ship. Healed by the wind. Off
shore. the Whales going quick to the ship
