Comm. with moderate breeze from NW by N. at 10 AM. Light air from NE. Mid. & L. Part. fresh breeze. Sent a new main sail. Split fly jib. Under the same. Lat. 25.51 Long 113.42

Bar. 29.90 Saturday May 14th 690
 Begins with strong wind from NW by W. head up. At 6 AM. at 3 PM. took in top. Gallant sails. Double reefed the top sails. & Mid. & L. Part. heeled to the weather. Lat. 26.00 Long 114.35

Bar. 30.10 Sunday May 15th 691
 Comm. with strong wind & high sea. at 6 AM. took in head. At 3 PM. under single reef. Lat. Part. more moderate. set all sail. took to the NW. Lat. 26.05 Long 114.25

Bar. 29.90 Monday May 16th 692
 Comm. with strong wind from NW. attended with a very bad sea. There is the most irregular sea. Off this coast. at times felt the force of wind. At 10 AM. at 3 PM. single & double reefed the top sails. Lat. Part. more moderate. set out the reef. at 6 PM. took to the NW. Lat. 25.33 Long 115.58

Bar. 30.03 Tuesday May 17th 693
 Comm. with fresh breeze & blowing head up. At 10 AM. at 3 PM. set. Lat. Part. light air & calm. Sailed at 5 PM. 5 pipes of oil. Lat. 26.18 N Long 115.07 W

Wednesday May 18th 694
 Comm. with light wind from NW by W. at 10 AM. the wind to the NW. sea a steamer. up to the head. Lat. Part. light air from NE & calm. At 10 AM. Island in sight bearing W by W. Lat. 10 miles. Lat. 27.00 N Long 114.45 W

 Begins with light air from NE to NW. at 10 AM. the land. took from W by W to NE. Lat. 20 M. at 6 PM. Mid. & L. Part. calm. Lat. 27.26 Long 115.19

Saturday May 21st 697
 Begins with light wind from NW. at 10 AM. the wind to the NW. sea grassy. & sea steamer. going South. Mid. & L. Part. light wind. Lat. 27.28

Sunday May 22nd 698
 Comm. with a fresh breeze from NW by W. at 7 PM. spoke ship. O. Crocker. 33 m. 800 sp. Mid. & L. Part. fresh breeze. withering up. off shore than I of Martinique. This day we are 2 weeks out from home. Lat. 27.33 N

Monday May 23rd 699
 Comm. with fresh breeze from NW by W. the O. Crocker. sailing. Mid. & L. Part. moderate. breeze head up. At 10 AM. sea. broke. Lat. 27.42 N

Tuesday May 24th 700
 Moderate breeze from NW by W. sea. a. big cutting at 7 PM. at 10 AM. Bonaire in sight. bearing NE. Lat. 20 M. South. Part. heavy. Lat. 24.42 N. Lat. 18 M. Lat. Part. bearing off Bonaire. Lat. 28.16 Long 115.43
